<b>Event Format</b>	Senior Compound archers will shoot on layered foam targets All others will shoot on straw bosses There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on full size faces for the round Ends of 6 arrows all day to be shot in timed ends of 4 minutes.			
<b>Awards</b>	Medals will be awarded for First, Second and Third place in each category. Awards will be made based on the highest scoring SINGLE ROUNDS			
<b>Dress</b>	All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307) <b>Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot.</b> See Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 for details			
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached			
<b>Refreshments</b>	Refreshments will be available throughout the day from the Supermarine catering tent			
<b>Photography</b>	Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first			
<b>Car Parking</b>	Please park in Supermarine Bowmen's lower field. Do not park on the grass by the shooting field or obstruct any gateways or pathways.			

<b>Lost Arrows</b>	The venue is a sports playing field and all arrows <b>MUST</b> be accounted for. All lost arrows must be reported to a judge. It is the archer's responsibility to locate any missed arrows before leaving the field. <b>If you intend to shoot all carbon arrows, you must indicate with your entry how <u>you</u> intend to find them should you miss the target.</b>
<b>Dogs</b>	No dogs are permitted on the premises.
<b>Smoking</b>	<b>Smoking:</b> If you need to smoke, please do so <b>in the clear area behind the catering tent.</b> This includes E-cigarettes
