| <b>Event Format</b>    | Senior Compound archers will shoot on layered foam targets<br>All others will shoot on straw bosses<br>There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on full size faces for the round<br>Ends of 6 arrows all day to be shot in timed ends of 4 minutes.   |     |  |
| <b>Awards</b>          | Medals will be awarded for First, Second and Third place in each category.<br>Awards will be made based on the highest scoring SINGLE ROUNDS   |     |  |
| <b>Dress</b>           | All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307)<br><b>Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot.</b><br>See Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 for details  |     |  |
